Personnel-General Civil Air Patrol Uniform Manual

This manual supplement prescribes additional procedures in effect for all Wisconsin Wing CAP units. Full understanding of this supplement may only be obtained by reading it in conjunction with the related paragraphs of CAPM 39-1.

CAPM 39-1, 23 March 2005 is supplemented as follows:

2-26. Men's Headgear

1. Added- Cadet Officers are authorized to wear the service cap.

2-28. Women's Headgear

1. Added- Cadet Officers are authorized to wear the service cap.

1-8 Table 1-3 Additional Items That May Be Authorized by the Wing/Region Commander.

Line 3 – Items That May Be Authorized

a. Added - Squadron Commanders may authorize squadron honor cadets to wear a black shoulder chord. The Wing Encampment Commander may authorize shoulder chords for various purposes for the duration of the Wing Encampment. Encampment shoulder chords may be of any colors that are not already designated for another purpose by National or Region Headquarters.

Line 4 - Berets

g. Added - Cadets that are members of either the Wing Color Guard or Wing Drill Team may wear a blue beret while performing functions related to the aforementioned teams. These functions may include, but are not limited to, practices, demonstrations, or promoting the Cadet Competition program within the Wing. Wisconsin Wing Color Guard and Wisconsin Wing Drill Team will be those teams that either win the WI Wing Cadet Competition in their respective areas, or are designated as such by the Wing Commander.
