CIVIL AIR PATROL UNIFORM MANUAL

CAPM 39 – 1, 1 July 1997, is supplemented as follows:

1 – 4f. Added. Senior members of the Georgia Wing are prohibited from wearing the military style uniform, CAP distinctive uniforms, summer or flying/recreational uniform combinations, the USAF flight suit, fatigues, or BDUs until they have completed Level I Orientation, to include the Cadet Protection Training Program.

1. Add to Ch 7, Section A, subsection 7 – 3a: The following shoulder cords are approved for wear within the boundaries of the wing:

Green	Wing's Outstanding Cadet of the Year
White/Blue	Members of the Group/Squadron Color Guards
*Blue	Wing's Representative to the Region's CAC
*Red	Group and Squadron primary representatives
*Red/White	The Wing CAC Vice Chairman, Recorder, and Staff

*Denotes wear is approved at all activities and only when holding this office.

2. Add to Ch 7, Section A, subsection 7 – 3g: The blue beret will be worn only by members who have completed the National Blue Beret Encampment at Oshkosh and have proper documentation to support such attendance. Berets will only be worn when wearing the BDU combination within the boundaries of the wing. Wear of the beret is **PROHIBITED** when on a military installation, unless permission is acquired from the Wing Commander. No other berets are approved.
3. Create Ch 7, Section A, subsection 7 – 3h: The official Wing Physical Fitness (PT) uniform will be a CAP Distinctive shirt (unit, activity, DDR, etc.), shorts (black or gray with minimal logos), white socks and tennis/running shoes.
