NMWG Squadron Emblem Update Project



New Mexico Wing (NM001)

(approved 6 Oct 2022)

The NMWG emblem consists of the official symbol and colors of New Mexico, a Red (Pantone 200 C) New Mexico Zia symbol on Golden (Pantone Yellow 012 C) shield. “Vigilant Wings”, derived from current style CAP wings raised 20 degrees from the horizon forming a shallow “V” shape with a full color classic CAP roundel at center.

“Vigilant Wings” represent the organization’s various aerospace/ aviation related themes, activities and missions; while its “V” shape evokes our motto “Semper Vigilans” and Volunteerism.

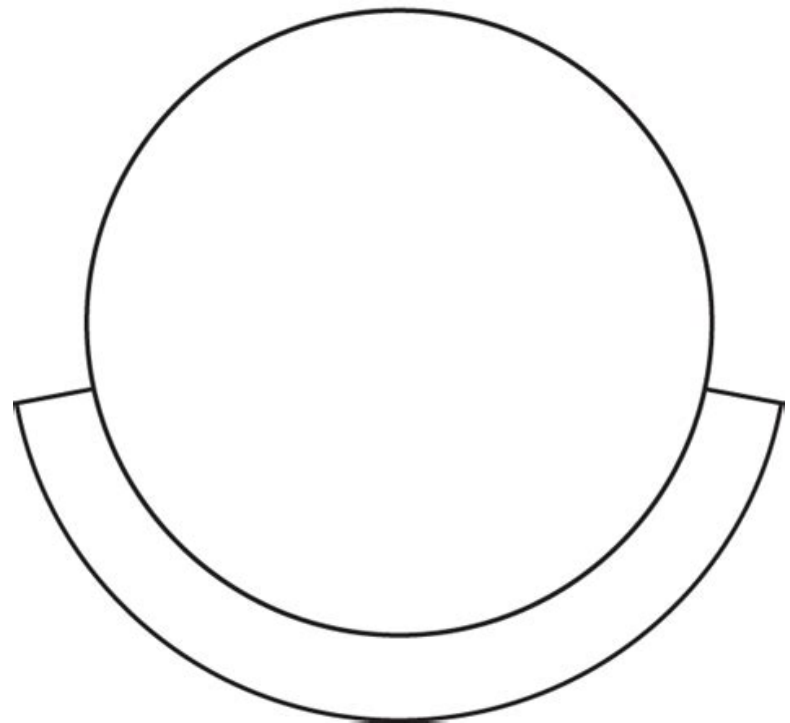

Disk elements:

- **Eagle:** Squadron namesake and mascot.
- **ZIA:** representing the State of New Mexico.

Colors:

- **Black** (HEX 000000): Eagle detail.
- **White** (HEX FFFFFFFF): Eagle detail.
- **Brown** (HEX 423E3D): Eagle detail.
- **Yellow** (HEX FFCD00): Border, Lettering, and Eagle detail.
- **Blue** (HEX 042C4A): Disk and Scrolls.
- **Red** (D42A2A): Zia.



Los Alamos Composite Squadron (NM016)

(approved 25 August 2025)

Disk elements:

- **AIRCRAFT IN NUCLEAR ORBIT:** representing Los Alamos ties to the atomic age.
- **ZIA:** representing the State of New Mexico.

Colors:

- **Black** (HEX 000000): Lettering, aircraft outlines.
- **White** (HEX FFFFFFFF): Scroll, Dexter orbit.
- **Yellow** (HEX FFCD00): Border, aircraft silhouettes.
- **Symbol Blue** (HEX 001871): Sinister orbit.
- **Red** (HEX BF0A30): Zia, Vertical orbit.
- **Tan** (HEX 847A65): Disk.



Santa Fe Composite Squadron (NM018)

(approved 28 October 2024)

Disk elements:

- **Flying Tiger:** Squadron namesake and mascot.
- **ZIA:** representing the State of New Mexico.

Colors:

- **Orange** (HEX FF9A2B): Lettering, Zia, Tiger.
- **Light Orange** (HEX F7CE7E): Tiger detail.
- **White** (HEX FFFFFFFF): Tiger detail.
- **Red** (HEX DC143C): Tiger mouth detail.
- **Black** (HEX 000000): Border, Tiger detail.
- **Green** (HEX 446930): Disk, scrolls.



Las Cruces Composite Squadron (NM024)

(approved 22 June 2024)

“SURSUM”; Latin for Upward appears on the upper scroll.

The Disk elements:

ZIA: New Mexico.

THREE AIRCRAFT/ CONTRAILS (constellation): “Las Cruces”.

ORGAN MOUNTAIN RANGE (Stylized): unique Las Cruces landmark.

Colors:

Black (HEX 212424): Border, Lettering, Mountain detail on lower disk.

Grey (HEX 56595C): Mountain detail on lower disk.

White (HEX FFFFFFFF): Aircraft and Contrails.

Yellow (HEX FFCD00): Scrolls.

Blue (HEX 0072CE): Sky on upper disk.

Red (HEX BA0C2F): Zia.



Albuquerque Senior Squadron II (NM030)

(approved 7 May 2024)

Disk elements:

- **Road Runner:** SQ II mascot.
- **ZIA:** representing the State of New Mexico.
- **Tri-blade Propeller:** representing CAP and aviation.

Colors:

- **Red** (HEX BF0A30): Border, Roadrunner, Zia, Propeller.
- **Yellow** (HEX FFD700): Disk and Lettering.
- **Symbol Blue** (HEX 001871): Scroll.



Clovis Composite Squadron (NM060)

(approved April 2019)

- The globe and compass rose represent Emergency Services. The wings represent Cadet Programs and Aerospace Education. The dagger represents NM060's partnership with the 27th Special Operations Wing based at Cannon AFB. The eight ball represents the image painted on "Hangar 8" which is leased from the City of Clovis. The words Facta non Verba mean "Actions Not Words".
- Green represents the Earth and farmland as the Clovis area is primarily an agricultural community.
- Black represents Volunteer Service; as volunteer professionals step up and rise to the occasion providing help to those in need in their "darkest times".
- Gold represents the core value of Excellence.
- Blue represents water, an essential element of life, as it is depicted on the globe.
- Silver, being a precious metal represents a commitment to being a valuable asset to the community, corporation and country.
- White represents purity, honesty and transparency reflecting on the CAP and USAF's shared core value of Integrity.



Farmington Composite Squadron (NM068)

(approved 5 Dec 2023)

- The two main symbols on the emblem are the Zia, which firmly connects us the New Mexico and the rampant horse. For more than a decade the Cadets have been addressed as “Pegasus Flight.” Pegasus was of course the flying horse in Greek mythology (interestingly, originally flying, but not with wings.)
- Once the horse was involved, the Cavalry colors (Army) came to mind and thus the diagonal division and the red over white. As our missions are often heavily connected to search/scout/observation tasks, the Cavalry scouting mission also seems analogous.
- Keeping the Zia sun symbol on the red, but essentially reversing the NM Flag keeps both Wing affiliation and location in the symbolism.
- Finally, the Motto of “Overwatch” in the upper banner/arc gathers the job of being a watchful sentinel and crisis response unit and reflects the Farmington unit’s unique location in relation to Farmington and the Three-Rivers/Totalah valleys. When we stand outside our hanger, we are literally in a overwatch position over a great deal of the surrounding territory.



Alamogordo Composite Squadron (NM073)

(approved 11 Aug 2024)

Disk elements:

- **ROCKET:** represents community ties to space program research.
- **ZIA:** represents New Mexico.
- **WHITE SANDS DUNES:** area landmark.

Colors:

- **Red** (HEX BF0A30): Border, Lettering, Left stripe, Rocket detail.
- **Yellow** (HEX FFCD00): Scroll, Zia, Dune detail Rocket detail.
- **White** (HEX FFFFFFFF): Rocket, Dune detail, Center stripe.
- **Symbol Blue** (HEX 001871): Rocket background sky, Right stripe.
- **Light Blue** (HEX ADD8E6): Zia background sky.



Rio Rancho Falcon Composite Squadron (NM077)

(approved 25 August 2025)

Disc elements:

- The Disk contains:
- **FALCON PROFILE:** Representing unit mascot/ namesake.
- **STYLIZED USA CRECENT:** Representing the USA.
- **ZIA:** Representing New Mexico.

Colors:

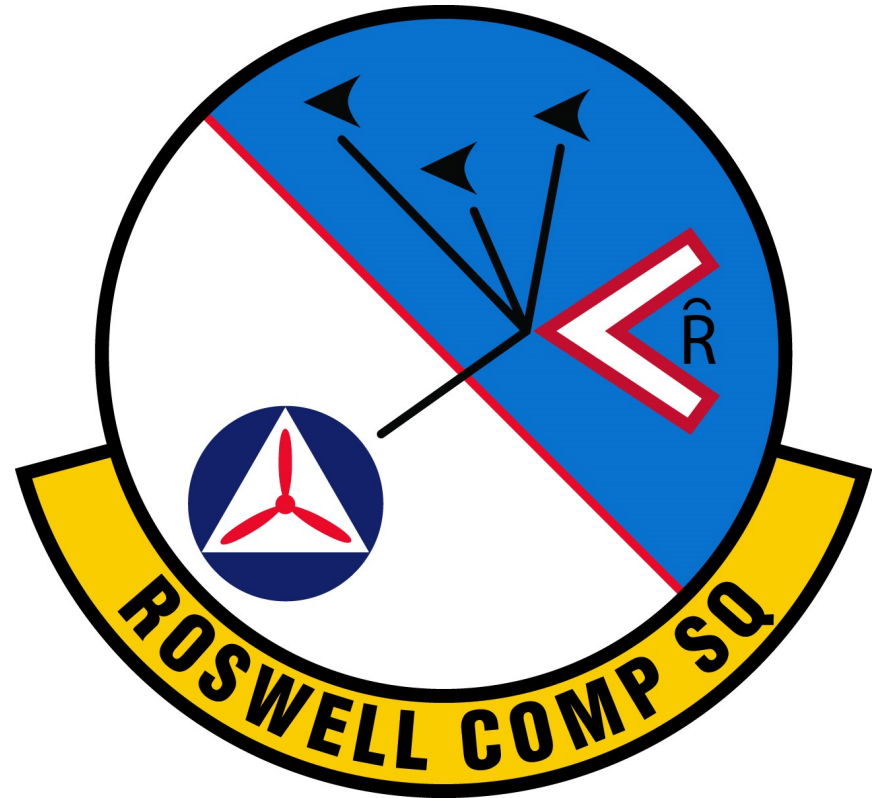
- **Red** (PMS 200): Stripes.
- **White** (White): Stars, Stripes, Zia, Scroll, Falcon detail.
- **Light Blue** (PMS 285): Disk, Star Field.
- **AF Yellow** (PMS 116): Border, Falcon detail.
- **Black** (Black): Falcon detail.
- **Brown** (PMS 161): Falcon detail, Lettering.



Roswell Composite Squadron (NM082)

(approved 2019)

Blazon – The Dexter is the Civil Air Patrol propeller emblem and the entire Dexter and Dexter Base is devoted to it and indicates this squadron participates in the three CAP primary missions. The Sinister is the horizontal red and white chevron with a Roswell cattle brand symbolizing a Roswell Squadron mission. The Sinister Chief consists of three black arrowhead elements to symbolize other mission assets working with the squadron and connected directly to CAP or other independent mission assets. The black intersection lines are mutual lines of communication and cooperation that connects the Dexter to the Sinister as well as the Sinister Chief elements. The white background of the Chief represents daylight and the blue Sinister background represents the sky. The USAF yellow scroll background represents excellence and honor.



Albuquerque Heights Composite Squadron (NM083)

(approved 3 August 2025)

Disk elements:

- **BORDER WITH 13 STARS:** original 13 colonies.
- **ZIA:** New Mexico.
- **MOUNTAIN:** representing Heights.

Colors:

- **Black** (HEX 000000): Sky.
- **Air Force Yellow** (HEX FDD000): Borders, Zia.
- **Red** (HEX BA0C2F): Stripes.
- **Blue** (HEX 0033A0): Scrolls, Outer Circle.
- **White** (HEX FFFFFFFF): Lettering, Stars, Stripes, Inner disk border.



Socorro Composite Squadron (NM084)

(approved 22 June 2025)

The Disk elements:

- **ZIA:** representing the State of New Mexico.
- **Tri-blade Propeller:** representing CAP and aviation.
- **Star/ Orbits:** representing Socorro's connection to technology/ science/ astronomy.

The colors:

- Blue (PMS 285): Disk, Scroll.
- Silver (PMS 422): Orbits.
- Red (PMS 200): Propeller.
- Orange (PMS 1655): Zia.
- Yellow (PMS 116): Border, Stars, Lettering.



Route 66 Composite Squadron (NM085)

(approved 16 October 2024)

Disk elements:

- **CAP Roundel.**
- **Route 66 Sign with Lightning Bolt:** Squadron namesake.
- **Cessna and Glider:** representing flight operations at home airport.

Colors:

- **Black** (HEX 000000): Sign detail.
- **White** (HEX FFFFFFFF): Triangle, Sign. Aircraft, Lettering
- **Yellow** (HEX FFCD00): Border, Lightning Bolt.
- **Symbol Blue** (HEX 001871): Disks and Scroll.
- **Red** (HEX BF0A30): Propeller.



Albuquerque Aviation Academy Cadet Squadron (NM855)

(approved 6 February 2024)

Albuquerque Aviation Academy's motto, as the school's primary focus is aviation, "**FUTURUM AVIATION**," Latin for "The Future of Aviation" appears on the upper scroll.

Disk elements:

- **Five planes:** representing the five Cadet milestone awards.
- **Zia symbol:** representing New Mexico.
- **CAP Tri-blade Propeller** at center of Zia.

Colors:

- **Symbol Blue** (HEX 001871): Disk.
- **Black** (HEX 00000): Border, Lettering.
- **Silver** (HEX 9EA2A2): Scrolls, Zia, propeller, planes.



Hozho Academy Cadet Squadron (NM865)

(approved 4 August 2025)

Disk elements:

- **Red Rocks:** represents local geography.
- **Wolf:** Academy mascot.
- **Moon:** represents the cosmos.

Colors:

- **Black** (Black): Border, Lettering.
- **Blue** (Reflex): Sky.
- **Silver** (PMS 422): Scroll, Wolf.
- **Turquoise** (PMS 3115): Moon.
- **Red** (PMS 200): Landscape/ horizon.
