This number may be used by all wings except **ALABAMA; ALASKA; HAWAII & PUERTO RICO.**

All orders placed on this line must be placed using either VISA or Master Charge Credit Cards. All orders must be for a minimum of \$10.00.

This number is for orders **ONLY**. It must not be used for any other reason. Other matters must be handled over conventional lines. Since the line is charged on an hourly usage basis unnecessary conversation is discouraged. Personnel have been instructed to determine immediately whether the incoming call is an order meeting the minimum requirements. Those not meeting these requirements will be terminated at once.

This procedure is necessary to insure maximum utilization which will permit us to continue the service. Personnel who abuse it will only cause its discontinuance with a resultant mail delay. We would like to emphasize that this is a **trial situation and the cooperation of all is requested.**

★ ACHIEVEMENT PACKETS ★

Effective 1 January 1978 the program governing the progression of Cadets through Phases I & II (Contracts 1 through 7), as it involves the Bookstore, was changed as follows:

As of 1 January 1978 the price of all study materials and contract for Phases I & II of the cadet program will be included with the initial cadet membership fee. The first packet and Contract No. 1 will be forwarded directly to the cadet when his membership application is received by National Headquarters. The first packet will contain all the study materials required to progress through Contract No. 7. If insignia or ribbons are needed, they may be ordered directly from the Bookstore.

Units may, if they wish, stock a few of the initial achievement packets (No. 1) in the unit. Then, when a new cadet joins the program, he can be issued his study materials at once. At the time he receives his first packet from the Bookstore, he can replace the packet he was issued by the unit. This, in turn, can be used for the next cadet who joins. This will permit a cadet to immediately begin work on the initial achievement while awaiting processing of his application and shipment of the first packet from National Headquarters. This could possibly save from 2 to 4 weeks since mail "lag-time" varies. THIS IS A SUGGESTION ONLY. ONLY A SMALL NUMBER SHOULD BE STOCKED.

TIPS TO PARTICIPANTS IN THE CADET PROGRAM:

1. Commanders are encouraged to stock Curry Packets, plus ribbons and rank insignia, for the first 7 Achievements. This will allow cadets to start working on Achievement #1 as soon as he joins; then replace the "borrowed" packet when he receives his packet from National Headquarters.
2. If the unit stocks rank chevrons (which are priced for all cadet enlisted grades at \$1.40), cadets may swap chevrons when the new rank is earned.
3. Stocking a limited number of the first 7 Achievement Ribbons will permit either the sale or presentation of the appropriate ribbon to the cadet immediately upon successful completion of a contract.
4. To prevent unnecessary delay in the cadet's progression in Contracts 2 through 7, all correspondence should be directed to CAP/USAF/TTHE and **not** the Bookstore. No further monies need be sent until submitting Contract #7. Then be sure to include \$6.00 for Phase III.

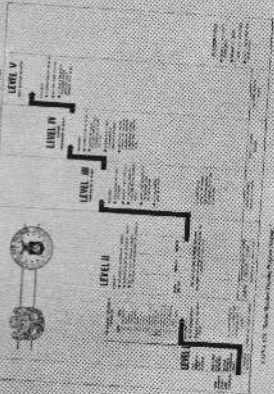

GENERAL INFORMATION

- a. The Senior Member Handbook may be ordered on an individual basis by the member concerned.
- b. The Senior Member Handbook may be bulk-ordered by organizations, if so desired.
- c. Senior Member Handbooks will be shipped fourth class postage, unless the individual or organizations desire to have the shipment made by a faster means and wishes to pay additional shipping costs. It is recommended that the Educational Materials Center be contacted to determine the additional costs involved. This is necessary because of the many variances which will be involved, such as number of packets ordered, method of shipment desired, distances involved, etc.
- d. Level I audiovisual training materials consist of a 35mm slide package and audio cassette tapes. This training is required of all persons who become senior members without progressing through the Cadet Program and earning the Mitchell Award. Normally the Level I Orientation training is conducted by wing level staffs.

In all cases orders should be made on the Bookstore Order Form, if available; however, orders by other methods will be accepted. Use of the Bookstore Order Form will expedite shipment, since orders received in any other format must first be typed onto an order form before processing can be accomplished.

It is realized that this new Senior Member Training Program will cause many inquiries from the field concerning its implementation. All inquiries concerning the publications and their availability should be directed to the Educational Materials Center. All other inquiries concerning administration of the program should be directed to DCS Training Attention: TT.
