3	1-12c	11	Change "(MR-U), Dallas, Texas, 75222" to "(PD-U), P.O. Box 660202, Dallas, Texas 75266-0202."
71	Item 18A	2	Change "as authorized in CAPM 50-5" to "must have been earned prior to 1 Jan 92."
72	Item 28B	4	Add: " Jumpsuit : Centered on right breast below the CAP seal and name-tape in a corresponding position to the Communications Patch."
72	Item 34B	5	Change "left" to "right."
72	Item 43	-	Add: "Aerospace Education Badge (as authorized in CAPR 280-2) Men : Centered below the pocket flap on the left breast pocket of the service coat or shirt when worn as an outergarment. Women : In the same position as specialty insignia (above the ribbons and beneath the wings). If the wearer is also authorized to wear specialty insignia, this badge may be worn above the ribbons and beneath the specialty insignia."
84	7-4j	-	Add: The Emergency Services Patch may be worn centered on the right breast below the CAP Seal and nametape in a corresponding position to the Communications Patch."
86	8-1a(4)	2	After "tie" add: "or CAP regimental tie (navy blue with red stripe)."
86	8-1b(5)	2	Between "bow" and "must" insert: "or CAP regimental floppy bow (navy blue with red stripe)."
90	9-10	5 thru 8	Change "pocket (or navy blue shirt. . .the CAP Bookstore." to "pocket, or navy blue personalized shirt with embroidered seal and gray slacks. These shirts are special manufacture items available only through the CAP Bookstore."

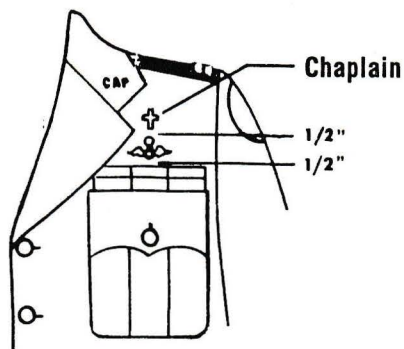

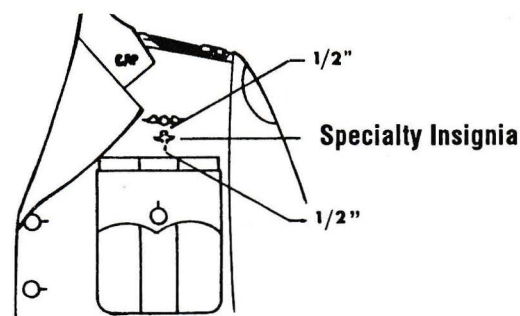

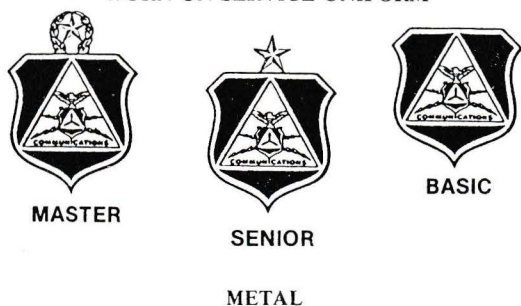

WORN ON FATIGUE SHIRT AND JUMPSUIT

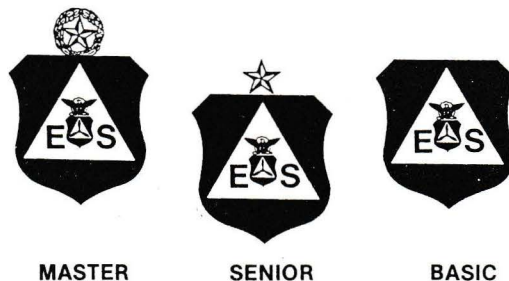


Figure 6-19. Communicator's Badge and Patch

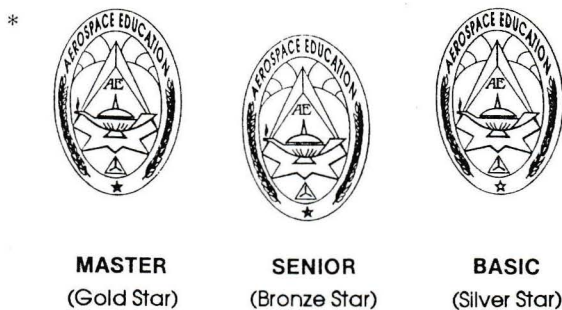


Figure 6-21a. Aerospace Education Badge

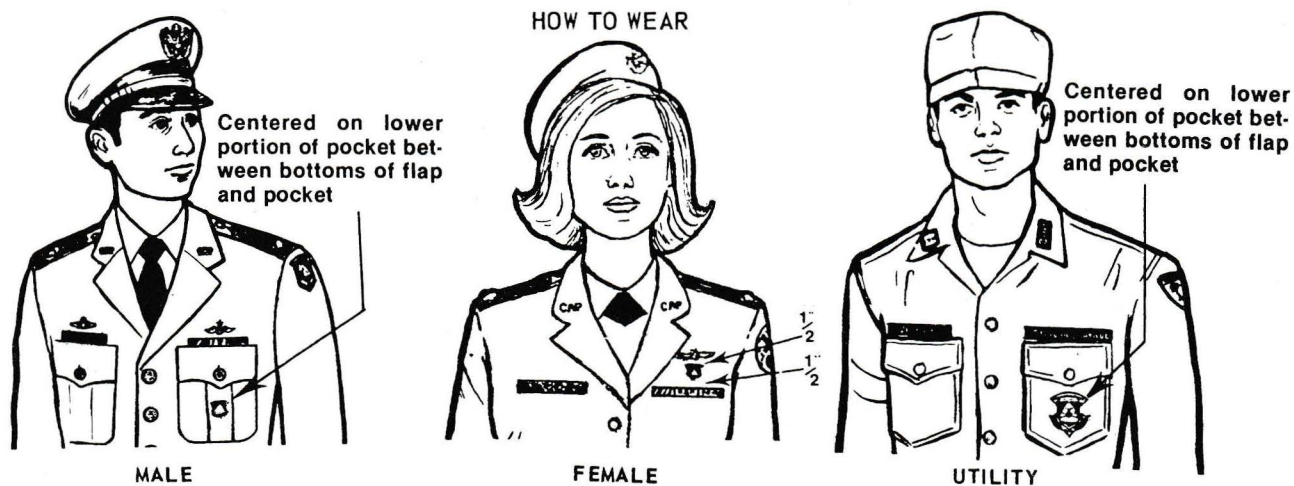


Figure 6-22. Placement of Badge Worn on the Pocket
